

## Advanced ChildFirst Georgia: Your Role In the Judicial Process July 28 - 31, 2025 University of Georgia School of Law - Athens, Georgia

<u>Eligible Participants:</u> **Forensic Interviewers and Investigators who conduct forensic interviews** who have previously taken ChildFirst GA or another nationally recognized 40-hour forensic interview training.

This advanced course is an intense, hands-on learning experience. The course focuses on increasing the knowledge and skills needed to provide effective testimony in cases of child abuse. ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO REVIEW MATERIALS prior to the training and PROVIDE MOCK TESTIMONY during the course.

PRIOR to the training, participants will be provided with pre-course reading materials on a mock child abuse investigation case. PRIOR to the training, participants will also be required to watch a mock forensic interview that was conducted by an experienced forensic interviewer with a professional actor. A link will be sent for the forensic interview video at least one week prior to the training.

Once the training begins, the group will dissect and process information revealed during the forensic interview and identify any potential challenges to the interview that might be posed during legal proceedings. Facilitators will engage participants in discussion regarding the various investigative and child protective factors associated with the case.

Discussion also takes place regarding the investigative and protective information collected post-interview, and what additional investigative steps should be taken as the case moves forward. Participants also explore various factors related to the prosecution of the case.

Faculty members will provide lectures on various judicial proceedings that may take place if the case is accepted for prosecution. Faculty will also provide lectures on additional topics including suggestibility, manipulative grooming, relevant research, and qualifying and testifying as an expert witness.

Participants will participate in multiple skill-building exercises to enhance their testimony skills. Participants will also have the opportunity to see various faculty members providing mock testimony.

ALL participants will then "take the stand" and provide testimony as witnesses in their respective roles. Following each participant's testimony, faculty and peers provide constructive feedback regarding the testimony.

There is a \$175 registration fee for this course. IF accepted to the course, you will receive a link to submit payment. Participants are responsible for their own lodging, meals and travel expenses.

\*\*\*Athens is very busy this time of year. If you choose to make travel arrangements prior to your acceptance to the course, make sure they are refundable in the event you are not accepted.
